## **Choose Hope**

Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen. Ephesians 3:20-21

What if...

Just think about it for a minute.

What if. What if today.

I remember, after my husband lost his job, no matter what He did, no matter what he tried, no matter where he applied, the answer was no. No, not you. No, not now. No.

And I remember, at one point, my husband saying, "It seems that just as I'm about to lose hope, another opportunity comes. And although they have all ended, so far, in 'no', it's been *just enough hope* to try again."

And today, as I sit and think and look back - at all God has done, how He's provided, how He's answered, and the new things He is bringing us through, I am reminded of the infinite love and grace of God.

Why? Because He knows. He knows. He knows we're human. He knows that although He can see the end from the beginning, we can't. And He knows that in order for us not to lose hope, we need help. We need Him.

Does it happen the same way every time? No.

Sometimes it's through His written Word. Sometimes it's through a friend or a stranger or a sermon or a song. But always, in all ways, God is giving hope. He is bestowing hope. He is infusing His children with hope.

And although it may seem small, it's always enough. Enough to hold on. Enough to say, "Yes, God, I will believe You. One more time, I will choose to believe You. I will choose to trust You. I will choose hope."

Is there an area of your life where you've almost lost hope?

I implore you, my friend, don't give up. Choose to believe God, one more time. Choose, in this moment, to believe Him, to trust Him, to hope...in *Him*.
